To convert the currently vacant land of DHA City Karachi into a vibrant living city, an aggressive development strategy has been formulated.




### IMMEDIATE ACTION DEVELOPMENT PLAN

Road and Infrastructure Works of Campsite.







- Major Road Works including storm water drainage, hydraulic structures like culverts, sewerage crossings, utility culverts and landscaping.





















Contractors with enormous infrastructure works experience like FWO, NLC and others are progressing at accelerated pace to complete the works as per schedule.






All works are executed under the supervision of our Consultant M/s. Osmani & Company (Pvt.) Ltd., and international standard quality of the works is being ensured.

Alhamdulillah, response from the plot owners is extremely positive as prompt payment of installments is provided by most of plot owners.









#### **BALLOTING OF PLOTS**

By the Grace of Almighty Allah in a simple yet elegantly orchestrated ceremony at Convention Hall of Defence Authority Country & Golf Club DHA Phase-VIII Karachi, the Balloting of Plot Numbers to Residential/Commercial Plots of DHA City Karachi (DCK) was held on April 23, 2013.



The ceremony was attended by a large number of people including dignitaries, DHA Officers, members of Armed Forces, plot owners and their families, real estate agents and members of the press.

In order to ensure a fair and transparent system, the balloting was organized by a computer based system. The computerized balloting was supervised by a Committee of Officers representing all three branches of the Armed Forces.


Around 27,000 residential and commercial plots of different sizes, which were allotted in 2009, were included into the balloting process.

In the residential category, 200 sq. yds, 250 sq. yds, 300 sq. yds, 500 sq. yds, 1000 sq. yds, and 2000 sq. yds plots, whereas in commercial category, 200 sq. yds, 300 sq yds, 500 sq. yds, 1000 sq. yds, and 2000 sq. yds plots were balloted.

A web based information system has been launched on the website of DHA, so that Plot No. and Sector No. could be easily checked by the plot owners.


#### APPROVAL OF ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT ASSESSMENT (EIA) OF DHA CITY

Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) for DHA city was completed and submitted by our Consultant M/s. Osmani & Company (Pvt.) Ltd. to Sindh Environmental Protection Agency (SEPA).



After a comprehensive evaluation and a public hearing which was attended by around 200 people and later meeting of expert's committee for due diligence, EIA was processed and approved by SEPA. This approval shows the commitment of DHA towards the sustainable and environment-friendly development at DHA City Karachi.





# PROVIDING OF BASIC FACILITIES TO THE VILLAGES


One of the first interventions done at site by DHA was to upgrade the basic facilities of the villages located in DHA land. This includes up-gradation / modification of the MASJID and SCHOOL at village Allah Dad apart from adopting the basic health care unit so that the quality medical facility is provided at their doorstep.


### DHA CITY MEDICAL SERVICE


The DHA City Medical Service project established in August 2009 has made considerable progress over the past 3.5 years in providing primary health care services where previously there was none thereby playing a small but significant role in breaking the cycle of poverty and poor health through affordable rural health-care unit.

Every month up to 100 patients visit the DHA City dispensary which is manned by a doctor twice every week. While government-run hospitals offer low-cost medical care, they are often inaccessible, crowded, understaffed and lacking medicines. DHA City dispensary serves the people of the area almost all of them who are poor or very poor. Indeed, since inception the centre has striven to provide primary health care to help break the cycle of poverty and poor health













DHA believes that health care has to be integrated with other social needs i.e. nutrition, clean water, good sanitation and family planning.

The services provided by the DHA City Dispensary are as follows:

- Free of cost medicines for general physical ailments such as
  - Respiratory tract infections
  - Skin allergies and infections
  - Snake bites
  - Cuts & wounds
  - Trauma
- Specialized medications for diseases like TB, diabetes mellitus, hypertension and asthma
- Special equipment like nebulizer gluco-meter, sutures, oxygen cylinders, etc.
- IV rehydration therapy is also provided

This initiative is an excellent example of social responsibility creating a bridge between DHA and the local community. The clinic is a testament to the fact that primary health care can be sustainable.

### ATTENTION ALLOTTEES OF DHA CITY KARACHI (DCK)

DHA Karachi is pleased to announce an incentive for the Allottees / Owners of DHA City Plots to clear their outstanding installments by **August 31st**, **2013** without payment of any surcharge. All those, who do not clear outstanding installments by **August 31st**, **2013**, will have to pay full amount of surcharge as applicable.

The fast track development at DHA City has commenced. Accordingly, all the utilities are also to be developed simultaneously. To facilitate DCK members and to lessen their burden for lump sum payment of utility charges, DHA has decided to recover the same in installments. The exact payment schedule will be intimated to all plot owners shortly.
