

DHACSS COVID-19 Check List (Teachers)

1.	All students to be seated as per the Govt. directive (1.5 m).	
2.	Students will not be left unattended at any time of the day for any	
	reason.	
3.	Students will stay in the class throughout the day.	
4.	For social distancing, the floors have to be marked with a tape inside	
	and outside the class.	
5.	Social distancing to be ensured by staff and students.	
6.	No activities which require close contact with the students will be	
	planned.	
7.	Class teachers must be in the class to receive; welcome the students.	
8.	Students will sanitize their hands every hour.	
9.	Staff and students will wear the mask throughout the school day.	
10.	Hygiene/safety corner is to be established in every class. Hand	
	sanitizer, masks, gloves, disinfectant spray, and tissues to be	
	available at all times.	
11.	Classes will be disinfected at the start and end of the day.	
12.	Safety SOPs posters to be displayed in each class.	
13.	Students must be trained to wear masks and to cover the face with	
	the elbow while sneezing or coughing. Discuss health and safety	
	habits and prevention of COVID 19 daily for 5 minutes.	
14.	Be patient with students and do not show agitation at any point.	
15.	Ensure that students take frequent water breaks.	
16.	Doors and windows to be kept open for good ventilation and	
	sunlight.	
17.	Students will bring snacks and water bottle from home.	
18.	Sharing of stationery books, snacks, water, or any other item will not	
	be permissible.	
19	Class work notebooks to be kept in the school.	
20.	Teachers will not take the notebooks home for correction.	
21.	Students will go to wash hands (before snack time) and restrooms	
	one at a time.	
22.	Monitor and identify any COVID symptoms. Immediately inform	
	school head and he/she will send the designated staff member to	
	take charge of the student. The concerned student will be taken out	
	of the class by the teacher and handed over to the dedicated COVID-	
	19 staff. No panic to be shown or created.	
23.	In case a student suffers from COVID-19, he/she will only resume	
	school after submitting a negative test report.	
24.	The teacher must inquire about sick students' welfare from parents	
	and send get well wishes regularly.	
25	In case a Covid-19 patient is identified the concerned class and	
	teachers will be quarantined for fourteen days at home.	
26	Used gloves, masks and tissues will be properly disposed off,	
	preferably in closed bins.	
27	No towels in wash rooms.	
28	Confidentiality of all matters to be ensured.
